ADMISSION TO ROTARY

Prospective Members are INVITED to join a Rotary Club Membership is NOT BY Application

Prospective Sponsor contacts Prospective Member and invites him/her to attend a Rotary Club meeting

Prospective Member can see how a Rotary Club functions and Rotary Club Members can meet the prospective member.

Prospective Sponsor should bring Proposed Member to ONE (only) Rotary Club Meeting.

Application for membership is submitted by Sponsor
Application is submitted for approval of Prospective Member
by Membership Committee

If approved, application is referred to Classification Committee

If cleared by both Committees, the Applicant is contacted to advise of these actions and advise that Applicant has been approved for membership processing.

Approval to circulate Applicant's name for membership to the Club Members is obtained from Applicant and name circulated to the membership

ATTENDANCE

Regular attendance of Rotary meeting is expected of all members.

New members cannot become acquainted with current members if there is sporadic attendance.

Older members cannot become acquainted with new member.

Rotary can function only with active, participating members

Three (3) consecutive missed meetings are grounds for automatic termination of Club membership.

A member must attend at least 60% of meetings at the Home Club

ATTENDANCE MAKEUPS

A member can make up a meeting two weeks before and expected absence or two weeks following an a missed meeting.
