



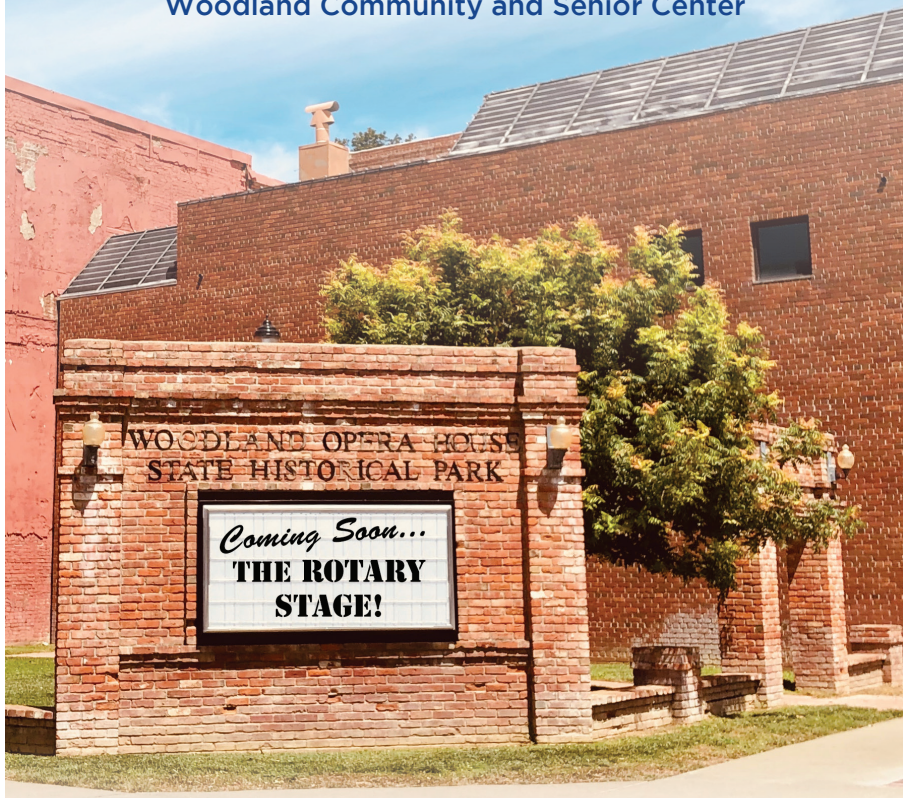

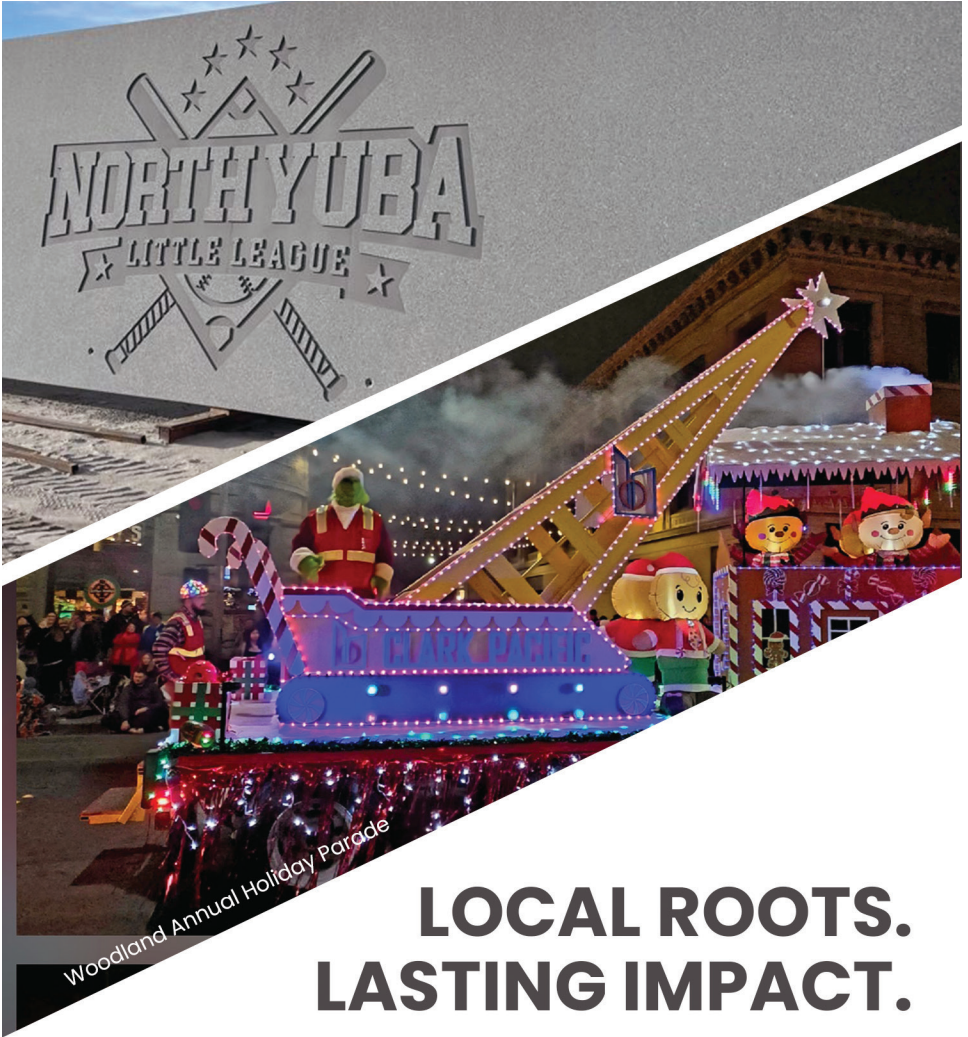

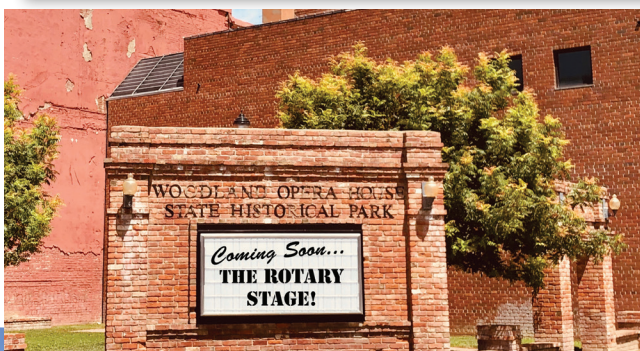


Rotary's 2026 Project: The Rotary Stage

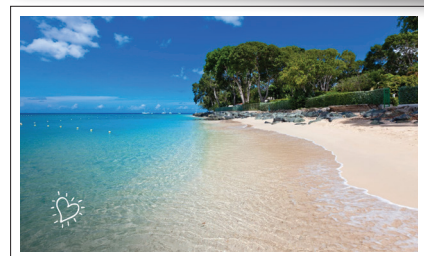

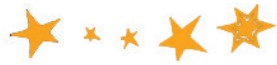

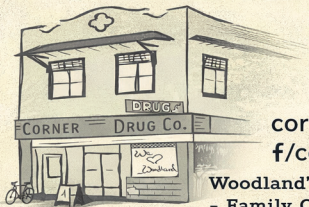
