EDIBLE FOOD RECOVERY

Requirements for Commercial Edible Food Generators



1. Maintain list of all food recovery organizations that collect or receives your edible food.
2. Maintain a written agreement(s) between generator and a food recovery organization which includes the following:
 - The name, address and contact information of the food recovery organization.
 - The types of food collected by or self-hauled to the service or organization.
 - The established frequency that food was collected or self-hauled.
3. Maintain quantitative data.
 - The quantity of food collected or self-hauled to a service or organization for food recovery. The quantity shall be measured in pounds recovered per month.
4. Maintain training records to ensuring an employee training program which discusses safe food handling procedures of recoverable foods is in place.

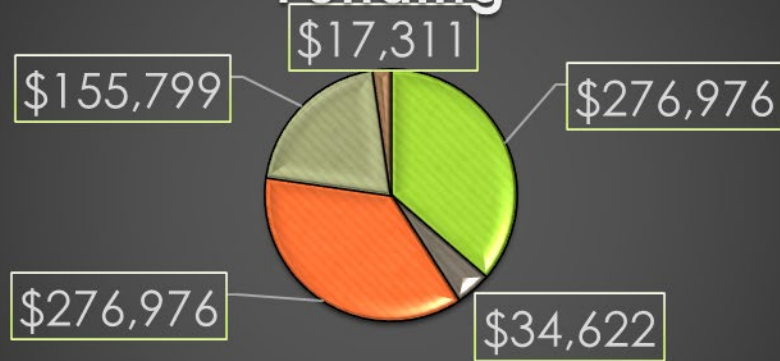

Meat & Bones

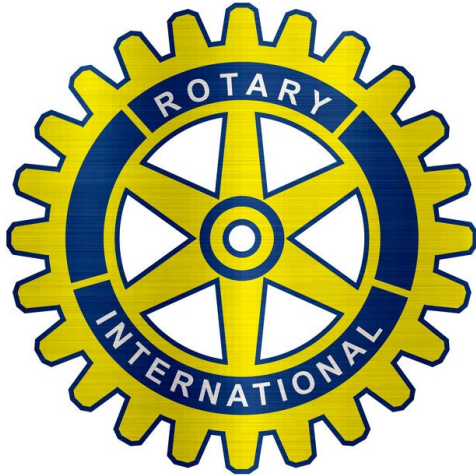

Service Organizations



- Waste Free Lunches/Meetings
 - Know the local food establishments that have biodegradable to-go containers and promote those restaurants
- Modify bylaws to include environmental goals
- Plan ahead to donate leftover food to Woodland Food Closet or Yolo Food Bank
- Fundraisers
 - Ensure onsite compost bins are available at event venue
 - Purchase paper plates, paper napkins, recyclable cups, etc.

WOODLAND

- Street pile collection of green waste during the same week across Woodland.
- Year-round access to “At Your Door” home pickup of household hazardous waste.
- Annual bulky waste drop off event in Woodland, in addition to the vouchers.
- Local designated CSR’s to Woodland.
- Expanded responsibilities for WM’s Recycling Coordinator for better support and compliance across the community.
