 Organizational meeting: April 29, 1926 Charter Presentation: July 9, 1926

History: A group of men met April 29, 1926 in the Board of Trade room to organize with the desire of applying to Rotary International for a charter for a Rotary Club. Officers were elected, the meeting day was set as Tuesday, the initiation dues as \$25., the annual dues as \$25. and the boundary line determined as "all of Yolo County north of a line running east and west thru Plainfield." The group were sponsored by the Rotary Club of Sacramento, assisted by the Rotary Clubs of Davis, North Sacramento and Grass Valley. It is of interest that the Rotary Club of Davis had received it's Charter only March 13, 1926. The 1st luncheon-meeting was held May 4th and the Rotary Club of Woodland was on it's way.
 The Charter presentation occurred at an evening dinner July 9, 1926 hel at the Parish Hall of the local Catholic Church and was attended by 23 persons. A copy of the Charter dinner is partially reproduced.
