

WHY CELEBRATE LITERACY

To share the JOY OF READING!

Children introduced to reading early on tend to read sooner and excel in school compared to children who are not exposed to language and books at a young age.

Students that don't read proficiently by the end of third grade are 4 times more likely to drop out of high school. (aecf.org)

Currently, 54% of students in Yolo County do not read at grade level. (code.ca.gov)
